How do I create a (guided) dialogue?

- 1. Understanding who I am, what I did and what's next
- 2. Selfreflection for engagement
- 3. Personal documentation and argumentation
- Reaching out to occupational and qualification standards
- 5. Accessing any open learning centre (*depending on the impact needed*)
- 6. Gaining ownership of **my** learning process in dialogue with the systems



Components of the dialogue

- Raising awareness of the value of learning
- An open dialogue about what has already been learned and what still needs/can/must to be learned
- Learning outcomes as building blocks for validation and learning.
- The portfolio as a (self)management tool.
- Guidance for accessing learning opportunities
- Assessment: of, for and as learning
- Tailored learning as the personalized learning path




VPL is the linking device

Validation of Prior Learning is a tool (or process) to help people get formal recognition for what they have learned through their experiences and for what they can do, know and understand.

What does it mean for providers?

- Create an open dialogue with learners (outreach)
- Offer guidance in all process steps
- Link validation and blended learning opportunities
- Capacitate staff
- Learning programmes in terms of learning outcomes
- Allow the personal portfolio to steer (lifelong)
 learning, and tune-in to the PERSONAL story/stories
